is a 10 voice chamber ensemble from the LaCrosse area specializing in early music of the 15th to 17th centuries. Mostly sung without accompaniment Madrigals, the secular part of the repertoire, can be sweet or silly or saucy but also soulful. These are poems put to music for a small group of amateur singers for their own amusement although composed by the best composers. It was the popular music of the day for the aristocrats and middle classes, sung in the language of the people in a social gathering - much like this one.
