**The mission of the American Legion Legacy Run is to raise money for Legacy Scholarships, which are open to children who have lost a military parent or in some cases, both parents, in combat.**

- 1.) At 7:30 am The Legacy Riders will leave Onalaska, travel through Holmen toward Galesville.
- 2.) At the Black River Bridge the Galesville Area Volunteer Fire Department will escort the 1 ½ mile long procession, along Hwy 53 to the Galesville Downtown Square.
- 3.) Estimated time of arrival is 8:10am; all 400+ motorcycles will park around the bandstand.
- 4.) A small group of approximately 20 dignitaries will break off from the group and head to Pine Cliff Cemetery for a wreath laying ceremony at the grave of William Roland McBride.
- 5.) After ceremonies at the cemetery and bandstand, the American Legion Legacy Riders will depart Galesville to Hwy 54/93 to continue their journey to the National Convention of the American Legion which is being held in Minneapolis, Minnesota where it was first held 100 years ago.
